Update on Sister Immacolata

Sister Immacolata Scarogni will appreciate your prayers as she does her follow-up testing and radioactive iodine treatment after thyroid surgery. It began on April 5 with a preliminary diet and this past week included blood work, injections, a radioactive iodine pill (was given in the hospital on April 16) followed by a three day "quarantine" period at home. The entire process will be completed by April 20. Meanwhile, Sister can follow her regular work schedule until the days of quarantine.




PSR Picnic
