What is "Priesthood Sunday?"

Priesthood Sunday is a special day set aside to honor priesthood in the United States. It is a day to reflect upon and affirm the role of the priesthood in the life of the Church as a central one. On September 26, parishioners are encouraged to offer a prayer of thanksgiving and offer support for our pastor Fr. Dennis Walsh and other priests who have served our parish. Consider sending Fr. Dennis Walsh, Fr. Tony Vera and Fr. Albert Beltz a note or card of appreciation for their dedication and leadership for our parish. I will have a basket at the entrance of the Church for notes. Priesthood Sunday was established in 2001 to honor Priesthood in the Church and recognize those who are called to this life of service.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)

In a spirit of love, the church welcomes those who are interested in discovering the richness of our Catholic faith to come together to discuss their personal journey toward God. The Rite of Christian initiation or RCIA is for:

- ◇ Those who were baptized in other faith traditions, but now feel called to become Christian.
- ◇ Those who have never been baptized or do not belong to a faith tradition, but now feel called to become Catholic.
- ◇ Those who were baptized Catholic, but never received First Holy Communion and Confirmation.
- ◇ Those who have received both Catholic baptism and First Holy Communion, but were never confirmed.

This discernment process typically runs from September through Easter. If you are interested in becoming Catholic or know of someone who might be interested, please contact Sister Immacolata.
